## Glass City Awards Five Scholarships

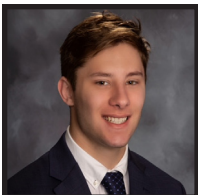
Five area students were recently awarded scholarships through Glass City's annual scholarship program for the 2023-2024 academic year. The scholarship program is open each year to qualified applicants, who are attending a two- or four-year accredited post-secondary institution. Scholarship applicants were required to write and submit an essay, and the winning recipients were selected by a panel of community business representatives.



**Elise Boyle** (\$1,000 recipient) is an Adolescent to Young Adult Integrated Social Studies Education major at Bowling Green State University (BGSU) and a 2021 graduate of Bowling Green High School. A resident of Bowling Green (BG), Elise is involved in the City's Black Swamp Arts Festival and Firefly Nights, and serves as a chairperson for the Human Relations Commission of BG. Her volunteer efforts at BGSU have benefited organizations including BRAVE (Black Rights Activism, Visibility, and Equity), the Falcon Leadership Institute, and Warm Up BG.



**Kaylee Dean** (\$1,000 recipient): A Bowling Green State University (BGSU) student majoring in Environmental Science, Kaylee graduated from Bowling Green High School in 2021. A BGSU Student Life Award recipient, she is a Honors College and Dean's List student. Her BGSU involvement includes the Outdoor Adventure Club, Student Green Initiatives Fund Committee, Eco-Fair, Green Team, Bloomfest, and Campus Restore. As a Bowling Green resident, Kaylee has volunteered for the Black Swamp Arts Festival, the Wood County Park District, and Bowling Green Parks and Recreation.



**Andrew Maassel** (\$2,500 recipient): A 2023 St. Francis de Sales High School graduate, Andrew is attending Bowling Green State University (BGSU) this fall, majoring in Pre-Med Biology.
